First Reconciliation and Holy Communion Programme 2025: Holy Family Parish

The programme is *family based and is parish based*

You need to be worshipping in this parish of Holy Family on a regular basis in order to apply for your child. As parents you will be asked to commit to attending each of the twelve facilitated sessions on the FHC programme, so that you support and guide your child. At least one parent/guardian will be supporting each child in all the sessions.

Your child will need to be present for all those twelve sessions and your child makes their First Reconciliation during the later stages of the programme, at one of our special Children and Family Reconciliation Services: please join in those services with the children. Parents we ask you please: can you sustain attendance and involvement with each of the sessions, for the sake of your child?

If your natural parish of worship is another parish than Holy Family then please apply for the FHC programme in that parish and introduce yourselves and involve in that parish programme.

Your child should have made their baptism. Our application form requires accurate details of the date and place of baptism: the certificate will be shown to Parish Priest and Catechists. Children being offered for Initiation and/or Reception into the Church: the parents/guardians will meet with Fr Graham.
