Introduction to the readings

The evangelists do not report the passion and death
of Jesus to play on our emotions but to tell the
truth as they witnessed. They show us Christ who
gave up his life for the love of humanity.

The first reading tells us what happens to those
who are faithful to the mission God has entrusted
to them. The Gospel presents us with the only One
who has fully realised in Himself the image of
Servant.

The second reading describes the journey of this
Servant from the glory of the Father to the
humiliation of the death on the cross, to the
glorification of his resurrection. Suffering is the
path God chose to merit the rewards of
glorification. When sufferings are accepted with
love, it becomes a prayer against the injustice of
the world.
