Introduction to the readings

The evangelists do not report the passion and death
Today's Mass celebrates the resurrection of our
Lord, Jesus Christ, from the dead. His resurrection
is a victory over sin and death and the unlocking of
the path to eternal life.
In the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles,
Peter proclaims the resurrection of Christ to
Cornelius and his household. This account reveals
that God does not show preference between
nations, races, tribes, and people. The resurrection
is a historical event testifying to the unconditional
love of God for humanity.
St. Paul in the Second Reading points out two
things, namely, that before baptism we live a
worldly life, and that after baptism, we live a life
in the resurrected Christ. Therefore, our Christian
attitude to life must be to walk this world with
heaven as our goal and Christ as our light.
In the Gospel, Mary of Magdala is the first to
witness to the resurrection of Christ. She becomes

the first evangelist of the Resurrected Christ and so
becoming an apostle to the Apostles. Like Mary,
every Christian is called to make Christ alive by
words and deeds.
