Opening Prayer

O God, who from living and chosen stones prepare an eternal dwelling for your majesty, increase in your Church the spirit of grace you have bestowed, so that by new growth your faithful people may build up the heavenly Jerusalem. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

The Lateran Basilica, built by the Emperor Constantine on the Lateran Hill around the year 320, is the cathedral of the Pope who is the Bishop of Rome. This Basilica, dedicated to the Saviour, to Saint John the Baptist and to Saint John the Evangelist, is considered the mother of all the Churches. The feast of its dedication reminds us of our calling to live in deep communion with the successor of Peter, the rock on which Jesus built his Church, and the one who confirms us in our faith. The readings help us understand that all baptised members of the Church are called to be the temple of God, and to bear fruits of charity and holiness for the good of all humankind.

On Sunday 7th Dec at 6pm all parishioners of Addlestone, Chertsey, Englefield Green, Esher & Thames Ditton, Hersham, Molesey, Walton-on-Thames, and Weybridge are invited to join the Mass of inauguration of the new parish of Weybridge, celebrated in CPP, Weybridge by Bishop Richard and the clergy of the deanery. In this Mass, all the afore mentioned parishes will be

united into one new canonical parish, led by the clergy of those parishes, with Canon Chris Spain as Moderator, as part of Bishop Richard's pastoral plan, "The Word who is Life". Sunningdale parishioners are also welcome, although their parish will remain outside of this new entity. In preparation for this event, and to present the key elements of change (and stability), there will be three open meetings to which all parishioners are warmly invited to attend. These will be geographically based across the new parish and held on three separate nights to give the maximum opportunity for people to hear about the plans and ask questions.
