Opening Prayer

Keep your family safe, O Lord, with unfailing care, that, relying solely on the hope of heavenly grace, they may be defended always by your protection. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

In the First Reading, Isaiah reminds us that true worship of God is inseparable from acts of love, justice, and compassion toward those in need. When we open our hearts and resources to the hungry, the homeless, and the afflicted, God's light breaks forth in our lives and in our communities. Mercy given to others becomes the very place where God's healing, guidance, and glory are revealed. St. Paul, in the Second Reading, teaches that faith is born not from eloquence or human wisdom, but from an encounter with the power of God. By proclaiming Christ crucified in humility and weakness, he allows God's Spirit to work freely in the hearts of believers. This reminds us that our trust must rest not in ourselves, but in God who alone gives growth and life. In the Gospel, Jesus calls us to be salt and light, reminding us that our faith is meant to be lived visibly and purposefully in the world. When we remain rooted in Him, our words and actions can preserve what is good and illuminate hope for others. By living authentic Christian lives, we draw attention not to ourselves, but to the glory of God at work within us.
