Opening Prayer

O God, who teach us that you abide in hearts that are just and true,

grant that we may be so fashioned by your grace as to become a dwelling pleasing to you.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

In the First Reading, Ecclesiasticus reminds us that God has given us the freedom to choose between good and evil, and with that choice comes responsibility. Life and death, blessing and curse, are in our hands depending on the paths we choose to follow. By seeking wisdom and turning toward righteousness, we align ourselves with God's will and experience the fullness of life He desires for us. St. Paul, in the Second Reading, reveals that God's wisdom is not like the wisdom of the world, but a hidden and mysterious gift revealed by the Spirit. What is truly valuable and eternal is often unseen, known only to those who are open to God's guidance. This reminds us to seek God's wisdom with humility, trusting that His plans surpass our understanding and bring life beyond measure. In the Gospel, Jesus calls us to live the fullness of God's law, not merely in outward observance but in the intentions of the heart. He challenges us to move beyond minimal compliance, embracing forgiveness, honesty, and integrity in every relationship. True discipleship, then, is measured by a heart transformed by love, justice, and mercy, reflecting God's righteousness in our daily lives.
