Opening Prayer

Grant, almighty God, that we may celebrate with heartfelt devotion these days of joy, which we keep in honour of the risen Lord, and that what we relive in remembrance we may always hold to in what we do.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

In the First Reading, we see how the message of Jesus brought both healing and joy to an entire city through Philip's faithful preaching and service.

The reading also reminds us that God often works through community, as Peter and John came alongside the new believers so they could receive the Holy Spirit and grow stronger in faith together. This challenges us to be open to God's work in unexpected places and to encourage others with unity, prayer, and compassion.

St. Peter, in the Second Reading, encourages us to speak about our faith with gentleness, respect, and confidence, even when facing challenges or opposition. Jesus' suffering for what is right encourages us to remain faithful and compassionate, trusting that God can use both courage and humility to reach others.

In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that loving Him is shown through obedience and a sincere desire to follow His teachings. We are comforted by His promise that we are never alone because the Holy Spirit remains with us to guide, strengthen, and encourage us each day. This Gospel inspires us to trust more deeply in God's presence and to live in a way that reflects His love to others.
