Receive the Holy Spirit

Opening Prayer

O God, who by the mystery of today's great feast sanctify your whole Church in every people and nation, pour out, we pray, the gifts of the Holy Spirit across the face of the earth and, with the divine grace that was at work when the Gospel was first proclaimed, fill now once more the hearts of believers. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

In Acts of the Apostles, the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost shows God's power to unite people of different languages and cultures through His message of salvation. This passage inspires me to be open to the Spirit's guidance and to share God's love boldly so others may experience His presence and grace.

In the Second Reading, Paul reminds us that the Holy Spirit gives each person unique gifts that are meant to serve and strengthen the whole community. Paul encourages us to value both my own role and the gifts of others, knowing that we are all united as one body in Christ.

In the Gospel, Jesus brings peace to the disciples in fear and uncertainty, reminding us that His presence calms anxious hearts. By breathing the Holy Spirit upon them, He empowers them to continue His mission with courage, forgiveness, and compassion. Jesus invites us to trust in God's peace and to share His mercy with others in my daily life.
