### **Opening Prayer**

God our Father, who by sending into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification made known to the human race your wondrous mystery, grant us, we pray, that in professing the true faith, we may acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory and adore your Unity, powerful in majesty.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

### **Brief Reflection**

In the First Reading, God reveals Himself to Moses not first through power, but through mercy, compassion, and faithfulness, reminding me that God's character is rooted in steadfast love. Moses' immediate response of bowing in worship challenges us to approach God with humility and trust, especially when we recognize our own shortcomings and the stubbornness of people. This reading encourages us to seek God's presence continually, believing that His forgiveness and guidance can renew both individuals and communities.

In Second Reading, Paul encourages believers to live in peace, unity, and love, reminding us that Christian community should reflect God's presence through mutual support and reconciliation. The final blessing about the grace of Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit gives us comfort because it shows that God remains actively present in every aspect of our lives.

In Gospel of John, we are reminded of the depth of God's love in giving His Son so that humanity may have eternal life through faith. This Gospel challenges us to live with trust and gratitude,

knowing that God's desire is not to condemn but to save and bring people into the light.
