### **Opening Prayer**

O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption. Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

### **Brief Reflection**

In the First Reading, Moses reminds the people that God used the hardships of the wilderness to teach humility, dependence, and trust in His providence. This reading invites us to realize that difficult experiences can become opportunities for spiritual growth and deeper faith rather than moments of despair. It also challenges us not to forget God's guidance and blessings when life becomes comfortable, remembering that true strength and security come from Him alone. In First Epistle to the Corinthians, Paul reminds believers that sharing in the bread and cup of Christ unites us deeply with Him and with one another as one body. He challenges us to see the Eucharist not only as a personal act of faith, but also as a call to live in unity, love, and mutual care within the community. In the Gospel, Jesus reveals Himself as living bread who gives eternal life, inviting believers into a deep and life-giving relationship with Him. We are reminded that spiritual nourishment comes from staying close to Christ and trusting completely in His sustaining presence each day.
