Opening Prayer

O God, strength of those who hope in you, graciously hear our pleas, and, since without you, mortal frailty can do nothing, grant us always the help of your grace, that in following your commands we may please you by our resolve and our deeds. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

In the First Reading, God reminds Israel that He has carried them out of slavery and calls them into a covenant relationship, not merely as a nation but as His treasured possession. This Reading invites us to recognize that, through Christ, we are also called to be a holy people whose lives witness God's love and faithfulness to the world. St. Paul, in the Second Reading, reveals the depth of God's love: while we were still sinners and unable to save ourselves, Christ died for us and reconciled us to the Father. As Catholics, we are called to live in gratitude for this gift of mercy and to place our hope confidently in the salvation won through Jesus' sacrifice.

In the Gospel, Jesus is moved with compassion for the crowds and calls His disciples to share in His mission of bringing healing, hope, and the Good News. He reminds us that the harvest is abundant and that every baptized Christian has a role in serving God's Kingdom according to their vocation. As Catholics, we are called to respond

generously to Christ's invitation, freely sharing the love and mercy we have first received from Him.
