Opening Prayer

Grant, O Lord, that we may always revere and love your holy name, for you never deprive of your guidance those you set firm on the foundation of your love. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Brief Reflection

In the First Reading, Jeremiah, the prophet, experiences fear, betrayal, and opposition, yet he places his trust in God, who remains his defender and source of strength. We are encouraged to persevere in faith during trials, confident that the Lord sees our struggles and will ultimately bring justice and deliverance.

In the Second Reading, St. Paul contrasts the sin of Adam, which brought death into the world, with the grace of Christ, whose obedience brings life and salvation to many. As Christians, we are reminded that God's mercy is greater than sin and that through Jesus we receive the gift of new life that restores our relationship with God.

In the Gospel, Jesus encourages His disciples not to fear those who oppose them, but to trust in the Father's loving care, who knows and values each person intimately. He reminds us that true courage comes from faith and from recognizing that our lives are held securely in God's hands. As Catholics, we are called to witness to Christ openly and confidently, trusting that He will acknowledge before the Father those who remain faithful to Him.

Day for Life 2026

This Sunday, 21st June, we mark the Day for Life under the theme "The Wonder of the Child in the

Womb." The theme also recognises the loss of children who died before birth and the grief of their parents.
