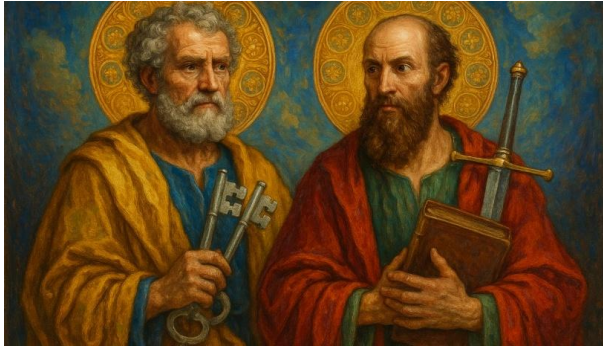

*Trust Christ, Remain Faithful, Persevere*

### Opening Prayer

O God, who on the Solemnity of the Apostles Peter and Paul give us the noble and holy joy of this day, grant, we pray, that your Church may in all things follow the teaching of those through whom she received the beginnings of right religion. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

### Brief Reflection

The First Reading shows that even in the midst of persecution and seemingly impossible circumstances, God remains sovereign and able to deliver His people according to His purpose. Peter's miraculous rescue reminds me to trust God's power and faithfulness, even when situations appear hopeless. Paul, in the Second Reading, faces the end of his life with confidence because he has remained faithful to God and trusts in the reward that awaits him. His words encourage me to persevere in faith, knowing that the Lord strengthens, sustains, and ultimately delivers those who belong to Him. In the Gospel, Peter's declaration that Jesus is the Messiah reveals the importance of personally recognizing and confessing who Christ truly is. Jesus' response shows that faith is a gift from God and that He builds His Church on the truth of His identity. This passage challenges me to deepen my faith in Christ and trust His authority to guide and strengthen His people.
