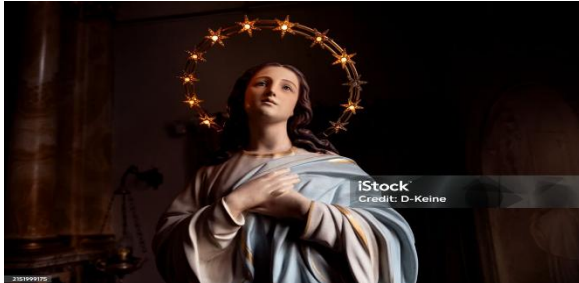

Elizabeth praises God for the news which the two women can share. The delicacy and respect shared between them is a significant aspect of the Gospel message.

In the Magnificat message Mary points away from herself to the honour that her child will be good news for all generations.
