The Episcopal Ordination of our Bishop-Elect will be celebrated in Arundel Cathedral at 12 noon on Monday 19th October, the Solemnity of Saint Philip Howard.

Our new Bishop will celebrate Mass at Worth Abbey at 11.30am on Saturday 24 October.

Opening Prayer

O God, who cause the minds of the faithful to unite in a single purpose, grant your people to love what you command and to desire what you promise, that, amid the uncertainties of this world, our hearts may be fixed on that place where true gladness is found.

Introduction to the readings

Our first reading speaks of the appointment of a new leader who will have the Key of David, who will open, and no man shut, shut and no man open. These words apply to Christ and to his Church. St Paul reminds us that God is mysterious, and everything comes from him and is for his glory. We read of Peter's profession of faith and Jesus recognising him as the Rock on which the Church is built.
