Opening Prayer

Look upon us, O God, Creator and ruler of all things, and, that we may feel the working of your mercy, grant that we may serve you with all our heart.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Reflection on the Sunday Scriptures

Peter feels he can solve the problem, the challenge of forgiveness, by counting the times. Jesus shows that in building God's kingdom, counting the times, remembering the times, we have or have not shared forgiveness, misses the point. The parables reveal the abiding, unfailing and abundant forgiveness of God – and invites God's household to be as unfailing and abundant in forgiving one another as the God who shapes and guides us. The counted number of talents in the parable is part of God's message. No one could amass such a debt. It would be impossible to pay it back. The master is so moved, that he cancels the lot. Yet the servants don't seem to learn from that, as the parable develops. Education Sunday is expressive of the learning we can impart, also the education we can draw out from one another. 'Education' really means drawing out from within. If we argue on that, we are like Peter; we are yet to understand Jesus' message.
